Memorandum to families

❖ What is an international section ?

International sections prepare students to obtain a French baccalaureate with a major in languages and literature (L), economics and social sciences (ES) or maths and experimental sciences (S). The diploma will indicate that the exam was passed with an optional international component in accordance with French legislation and diplomatic agreements. The diploma with this specific stipulation indicates that the student received a bilingual as well as bicultural education enabling him/her to register in English-speaking colleges and universities. It is a 3-year long program yet final examinations of the OIB cover the curriculum taught during the last two years.

❖ Expected profile

Grade 9 students who are particularly interested in studying the language, the civilization and the literature of the section. They must have strong potential to become bilingual. They must be autonomous and able to handle a heavy work load. Expected level : B2

❖ Schedule

The duly completed application file has to be sent to our school, postmarked by the 12th of May at the latest. When you send your form, it means you are expected to take the written test on the 17th of May 2017 at 10 a.m. at Lycée Argouges.

The oral test will take place on the 17, 18 and 19 according to the notification you will receive on the 17th after the written test.

The candidates who live the farthest will take their test on the 17th from 2 p.m. onwards.

❖ Application files should include the following :

- ☐ - a letter by the applicant in support of his or her application. His or her family's motivation. (Page 4)
- ☐ - recommendations from the English teacher, the French teacher, the homeroom teacher and the principal;(Pages 3 and 4)
- ☐ - Any valuable linguistic experiences (stays in an English-speaking country, school exchange with English-speakers, bilingual from infancy ...) ;(Page 4)
- ☐ - copies of school reports from the 8th grade and the first two reports of the 9th grade.

Students who do not attend a French school can join a copy of their final test report of the 8th grade and the end of term reports of the 9th grade.

The teachers and the principal will comment on the student's abilities to follow classes delivered in French and in English.

❖ Selection

A commission will base its selection on the documents in the application files sent by the applicants and their results to the written and oral tests.

On the AFFELNET form, the 1st choice must be ' lycée Argouges - section OIB AMERICAINE'.

Selected students will receive their admission notification through the AFFELNET procedure.

❖ Results, admission and registration.

Students' admission will ultimately be decided by 'Madame la Directrice Académique des Services de l'Education Nationale' at the end of June 2017 when the 'AFFELNET' procedure is completed. The notification will be sent at the school attended by the student.

No information about the results will be provided prior to this final decision either by Lycée Argouges or the student's school. Hence it is absolutely essential that all the candidates should indicate other wishes on their AFFELNET form, including at least their district high school, in case they are not admitted in the American section at Lycée Argouges.
